

## **AREE UTILIZZATE PER LA SOMMINISTRAZIONE NEL PERIODO ESTIVO.**

### **SEASONAL OUTLETS OPEN DURING THE SUMMER.**

The owners of bars or restaurants may apply for a Council permit to put tables outside their premises, provided:

- the dining area where customers will eat and drink is surrounded by flowerpots or panels to restrict the passage of passers-by;
- the dining area where customers will eat and drink must not be near to roads or squares with a lot of vehicle traffic; in this case, they must be surrounded by hedges or panels that are at least 1.80 metres high.
- the dining area where customers will eat and drink must be paved so refuse can be removed and it can be cleaned easily;
- the outside dining areas of restaurants, brasseries and small outlets (see datasheets 2/A, 2/B and 2/C) must be enclosed (even if the roof is temporary) so that the food and tables are protected against bird droppings and falling leaves and flowers.

The owner of the outlet must state that all these requisites can be met when applying for the Council permit.
