AIM OF THE CONFERENCE

The conference aims at expanding and exchanging knowledge and practice on the use and evaluation of clinical pathways at international level, in order to improve clinical daily practice, organization and patient safety.

The Conference is divided into two parts: the National Conference will take place on October 29, 2015 (Language: Italian). The International Conference will take place on October 30 & 31, 2015 (Language: English).

An Italian-English simultaneous translation service will be provided on the mornings of 30-31 October 2015.

ABSTRACTS SUBMISSION

We hereby invite you to submit an abstract. Abstracts on the development, implementation and evaluation of care pathways or the (re)design of care processes in all sectors of healthcare are welcome. POSTER PRESENTATIONS

Poster presentations are visual displays of material which will be displayed in the exhibition area throughout the conference, and presented during the coffee breaks and lunches by the authors.

ORAL PRESENTATIONS
